



## Parent/Carer Remote Learning Agreement

We appreciate your commitment to supporting your child to engage with online learning. The agreement below will help to ensure the safety of the children, families and staff whilst learning remotely.

To facilitate online learning, parents should:

- Support children with accessing the lesson if required
- Provide children where possible children with a workspace that is quiet and safe, with an adult nearby to support if necessary (age appropriate)
- Support children to adhere to behaviour expectations as outlined at the start of each session
- Ensure face-to-face communication is only between teachers and pupils, unless immediate parental support is required
- Seek help from the school if required
- Allow lessons to proceed without interruption
- Notify the school if your child is sick or otherwise unable to complete work

To keep all children safe, parents must:

- Not record or photograph live sessions or other materials featuring pupils
- Ensure children are dressed appropriately
- Raise concerns via the normal school's complaints procedures and not during a live session
- Not allow third party access to the school's online environment and systems
- Abide by the conditions set in the school's Online Safety and Acceptable Use Policy, Remote/ Blended Learning Policy and Home School Communication Policy and Parent Code of Conduct.

By accessing the school's remote learning platforms, you agree to the remote learning agreement as set out above, and agree to abide by its conditions. Breaches of this agreement may be an offence, where the Computer Misuse Act 1990 and Data Protection Act 2018 apply.
