## MUSIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN SUMMARY: ARGYLE PRIMARY

This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

### PART A: CURRICULUM MUSIC

Music plays an integral and established part of school life at Argyle Primary School. We aim to provide opportunities for all children to create, play, perform, listen, analyse and enjoy music across a wide range of periods, genres and styles. We value the importance of ensuring all children have the means to learn an instrument and the ability to read notation. That children go to secondary school with the key to unlocking their musical potential.

The objectives of music teaching at Argyle are:

- Children use their voices to sing, express themselves, create and compose music.
- Children are given the opportunity to perform, listen to, review and evaluate their own and others' music across a range of time periods, genres and styles.
- Children learn to read and explore notation and understand musical terms
- Children have the opportunity to learn an instrument and use instruments to create and compose music.
- Children develop an understanding of how music technology is used in creating and recording music.

Our Music Curriculum follows the National Curriculum objectives. From the EYFS up, children are taught to read music in different forms and this skill is used regularly in lessons. In Year 4 and 5, every child learns to play an instrument with their class as part of the Everyone Playing In Class project. In Years 3, children learn basic knowledge of a range of instruments, including djembe drumming, tin whistle and keyboards.

Every child receives a weekly music lesson taught by a specialist music teacher (Nursery: 30 mins; Reception: 30mins; Year 1: 60mins; Year 2: 60mins; Year 3: 60mins; Year 4: 45mins; Year 5: 45mins; Year 6: 45mins).

In addition to this, Year 4 and 5 have a weekly 30 minute instrumental lesson on either violin or recorder, as part of the EPIC scheme. There are also weekly whole school singing assemblies. Music is embedded in teaching and daily routines in EYFS, and class teachers confidently bring music into the curriculum.

In order to enrich our music curriculum even further, we collaborate with some fantastic local music organisations such as the Camden Music Hub, Royal Academy of Music and the Aurora Orchestra. We greatly value these partnerships as they enable us to offer a broad music curriculum to pupils.

## PART B: CO-CURRICULAR MUSIC

-We offer **peripatetic lessons** on a range of instruments at Argyle Primary School. These lessons are taught during school time by visiting Camden Music Service tutors. Children sign up for lessons in advance and receive 10 lessons per term. The school offers financial support to children that do not have the means to pay for lessons, but show commitment and enthusiasm. The school lends out guitars, violins and recorders at no cost to the parents. Other instruments can be hired from the music service.

Instruments offered:

Percussion – Drum kit

Strings –violin, guitar

Woodwind – recorder, flute, clarinet, saxophone

Piano/keyboard

-At Argyle Primary, we have a thriving **choir**. The choir is made of KS2 children and rehearsals take place on Mondays during lunchtime play. Over 40 children consistently attend this free club, this shows the great commitment children at Argyle have towards singing. The choir loves to perform both in and outside of school. They always participate in Camden music events, such as the Camden Music Festival at the Royal Albert Hall. The choir enjoys showcasing at major school events and share songs with parents and the school during assemblies.

-Last year, Argyle is started an **instrumental ensemble**, inviting interested and enthusiastic Year 6 children to join. Children showed a big interest in learning guitar, so guitar was the main focus. Children learnt specific songs, but also skills that they can take into future instrumental playing.

We encourage our young musicians to make music outside of school by joining the Camden Music Service Ensembles. Musicians from Argyle Primary can be members of Camden SuperBlast, SuperString, SuperStrike and SuperToot, which take place every half term. Camden Music also run an extensive Saturday morning centre where children of all ages can take part in a range of music making activities from learning an instrument to singing in a choir or playing in an ensemble. These ensembles are a stepping-stone into the senior bands and orchestras in Camden and provide opportunity to further ensemble playing skills.

## PART C: MUSICAL EXPERIENCES

There are plenty of performance and enrichment opportunities for children in and out of school throughout the year. Here are some of our regular performance opportunities and musical experiences:

-Our EYFS and KS1 children attend the **Aurora orchestra** concerts at King's place at least once a year, where children are active participants in stories and songs that are specifically aimed at their age groups.

-We have a close link with the **Royal Academy of Music**. This means that whenever suitable workshops or concerts take place, we are offered free spaces. This year, Year 4 will be composing songs around their topic (Invaders and Settlers) with musicians from the Royal Academy of Music.

-Our Year 2 children perform at **Euston station** once a year, singing carols to raise money for the Lord Mayor's chosen charity.

-Year 2 also participates in the **Camden KS1 Singing Festival**, where children across Camden gather to share joint repertoire as well as performing individual items.

-Our choir participates in annual choir festivals. On alternate years, the **Camden Choir Festival** takes place at the Royal Albert Hall. Last year, we performed in the **Royal Albert Hall**, alongside roughly 2000 other children singing and playing instruments. Year 5 children, who showed enthusiasm during their Everyone Playing In Class sessions, were selected to play violin or recorder in the Camden WCET band at the Albert Hall.

-Every summer, our EYFS and KS1 children perform to parents in our **EYFS/KS1 Summer Singing Extravaganza**. This concert consists of joint repertoire, as well as individual items by each year group. It showcases the excellent progress children make during music lessons, and the clear progression in ability from Nursery to Year 2.

-Our Christmas **Nativity** is performed by Year 2 and packed full of songs, dances, fantastic acting, costumes and excitement.

-Year 6 have the opportunity to showcase their musical talents in the **Year 6 Production**. Productions are always of a high standard and a highlight of the school calendar.

-To welcome the change of seasons, ALL of Argyle Primary School participates in our **May Day Festival**. Children learn songs and dances and enjoy traditional May Day music.

Performing and attending concerts are part of our curriculum and enrichment experiences and children thrive when given the opportunity to share their musical talents and show their hard work.

Music at Argyle Primary will continue to be an integral part of school life. We will ensure the continuation of all that we offer and are always looking for more performance and enrichment opportunities. The music curriculum is reviewed every year, to ensure the quality of teaching and learning remains high. We will again be establishing an instrumental ensemble, making sure to listen to the children's interests and needs for what the ensemble might look like. This year, we will open the ensemble up to Year 5 students as well, to ensure some continuation for the next year. The Djembe drumming club, offered by Camden Music Service in Summer 2025 was a huge success. Children thrived and reached a high standard of playing in a short time. We would like to seek out similar opportunities for after school music clubs this year. From Autumn 2025, we will be offering a set number of instrumental grants, to make it possible for all interested students to have peripatetic lessons, regardless of the family's ability to pay. These grants will be offered to students showing interest and commitment to learning an instrument, not necessarily on current ability. This is an investment in future abilities and children's wellbeing.
